## Committee meeting 28<sup>th</sup> April 2026

The minutes of the previous meeting have been read and agreed.

1. Financial report: as of 28/04/26 £8543.08 balance in the account.

£697.50 belongs to Comp fees. £6095.64 attributed to Charity with £5,000 from The Park Hospital and a £100 donation by Alan Lerner for 'beat the pro' at the Ladies' Charity event. Available funds £1749.94.

1. Competition report:

Steffi keeping track of member's qualifying cards and informing individuals if they require more before they can take part in a trophy competition.

Participants will be allowed to enter the knockout tournaments on the proviso they have enough qualifying cards by the time they play their first match. We have 16 entries for the Singles KO so four rounds with no bye. 10 Pairs entered the Pair's KO so also four rounds required with byes in the first round. The first rounds for both must be finished by the 15th of June the second round by 31st of July, 3rd round by August 31st and final round by September 30th. £5 to player per KO.

Participants are reminded that they are responsible for making sure their card is correctly marked when submitted. Steffi will put up a poster again with an example and a short explanatory session can be held if needed.
